## Donation of Medicines to the host and mining communities of the Province of Dinagat Islands

**November 2016, Dinagat Islands**– For several years, the Philippine Mining Development Corporation (PMDC) has already been providing medical support to augment the basic health needs of its host mining communities.

For Calendar Year 2016, aside from the Medical Mission, PMDC also donated basic medicines to its host and neighboring communities in the Province of Dinagat Islands.

PMDC distributed PhP 150k worth of supplies of vitamins, antibiotics, and other medicines to the : (1) Provincial Health Office of Dinagat Islands; (2) Municipal Health Office of Loreto, Dinagat Islands; (3) Municipal Health Office of Basilisa, Dinagat Islands; (4) Barangay Health Station (BHS) of Panamaon; (5) BHS of Esperanza; (6) BHS of Edera and Navarro; (7) BHS of Pantinople and New Nazareth, Sta. Monica, Villa Ecleo; (8) BHS of Sering; and (9) BHS of Ritaglenda.

In order to monitor and track the beneficiaries of the said medicine supplies, the health units agreed to provide PMDC quarterly reports on the dispensed medicines.

The donation of medicines is part of PMDC's commitment to contribute in the development of its host and neighboring communities through its H.E.R.O. Program, collectively dubbed as Health, Education/Environment, Rural Infrastructure, and Opportunities to earn (livelihood).
